

Linn Mar Booster Club Meeting

Minutes

January 9, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m.

1. **November Minutes** – (MSC: Tracy/Kaufman) Approve the November minutes as distributed. All Ayes
2. **Treasurer's Report** – Beth reported on the income statement through December 31, 2011. Net revenue is \$101,511 as compared to last year's revenue of \$81,924 (gross sales less cost of goods sold).
 - a. **Hy Vee clothing rebates** – Marion Hy Vee sent \$132 for clothing last year; there was a question as to whether the Booster Club received any proceeds from clothing sales at Hy Vee and Hy Vee Drug Stores.
3. **Old Business** –
 - a. **Worker passes** – discussion of the letter from Scott Mahmens and Tonya Moe regarding asking parents to volunteer to work concessions in order to earn funds for the Booster Club but then giving passes to events that reduces the income to the Athletic Department. Tami expressed concern that eliminating the 12-punch passes for parent representatives may make it difficult to find parent representatives, but doing away with single passes for those who work concessions starting next year would be fine. Beth proposed that distribution list workers (not affiliated with any specific activity) or photo volunteers would be issued a ticket for concessions for the next event.

(MSC: Tracy/Hilsenbeck) Beginning next school year, single event passes will no longer be provided to volunteer workers. All Ayes
