2. **Treasurer** – Beth, Gross profits \$127,629.79 as of April 30, 2013. Collected \$170 in bad checks.
 - a. New treasurer: Steve Schuring – three kids at LM. Works in finance at ACT in IC. Treasurer of LM Foundation.
 - b. Middle School income - \$10,000+ for concessions.

5. **President's Report** – Compared LM's booster club dollars to other Iowa schools. LM \$144,000. Bettendorf \$123,000 (Athletics), CR Jefferson \$100,000 (Athletics), Ames \$85,000 (Athletics), CR Kennedy \$77,000 (Athletics), IC City High \$70,000 (Athletics), CR Wash \$67,000 (Athletics), Xavier \$67,000 (Academics, Arts, Athletics), WDM Valley \$63,000 (Athletics), Urbandale \$55,000 (Arts, Athletics), Johnston \$50,000 (Athletics), Marshalltown \$35,000 (Athletics).
6. **Clothing** – Smart phone credit cards: get with treasurer for application. With smart phone, no monthly fee, pay a 2.7% processing fee. Would work well for clothing. Pete is cautious about using at concessions. Concern about Square Up breaking off in personal phone. Chris, Beth and Steve will get it ordered and put in bank information. Beth will cancel old credit card from FSB as it has a monthly fee.
7. **Concessions** – Spring concessions down, bad weather. Popcorn popper died. Cost \$1750 to purchase a new one. New softball/baseball complex. Nice concessions. State Speech February 8, 2014 – booster club has first rights – people serve Subway, Zio John's, 2,000-3,000 people here all day long. The only money maker for the speech team if they do concessions. We could do a dual food court and have kitchen serve and booster club do concessions.
