- 1) **Nov Minutes** – approved, all ayes.
- 2) **Treasurer** – Paula, Elizabeth Wilson will be the new treasurer effective today. Will stay on and transition to the treasurer role. Has a lot of experience. Looking forward to getting more involved in the community. Paula will stay on and transition Elizabeth.
  - a. Income for concessions up about 20K, the city wide marching band event brought in a lot of money. What is concession expense – other? \$11,267.73. (Is this the money for the softball fence?) Total concession expenses need to be looked in to? It's 15K more than last year. Look into it and get back to us at the next meeting. Kim will give out reminders for next year's budget soon, they remember they have money for the current year and get those submitted.
  - b. \$6,000 academic honors grant – June 30<sup>th</sup> last year shows that it was never spent. Where is it? It was spent, but doesn't show up anywhere.
  - c. Post Prom – who is in charge for this year?
- 3) **Old Business** – Pete, reimbursement passes, talked to Tonya. Business directors throughout the community are getting together to discuss sports camps. It's all metro schools. They are going to come up with a plan of attack to see what everyone's going to do to make it equitable. We will do whatever everyone else is to follow the rules. State education department is mandating this. Kim said we'll find out more before long. It shouldn't cost so much for the kids to be involved in some of these things, need to cut back on some of these expenses for the kids and their families. How do you perform in show choir if you don't have all the costumes, three changes? Sports camps, they charge various amounts. Should only cost the amount of the expenses for the camp. Will the camp provide as much if they can only charge minimal amount? Kim said nothing that needs to be done now, but that it will be looked at in the near future.

- 9) **Photos** – Carol - has someone that may be interested in taking over her position. Spring soccer and baseball coming up for this school year.
- 10) **Volunteer Coordinator** – no report.
- 11) **Kim Buelt/Scott Mahmens/Tonya Moe** – Construction has moved all their trailers out over break, working on punch lists now. Some major items left to do but list getting smaller. Lecture hall not done yet, maybe the end of January. May hold about 200 people. Equivalent to two classes. Open House on Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup> from 1:00 - 4:00 PM.
